1. Minutes of previous meeting - AGM

- (a) Tabled by Michaela Smith and accepted.

2. Business arising from the Minutes – Register of members

- (d) Discussion as to new branding for association – website to be updated and re-launched for January 2020.
- (e) Shaun to apply to 99 Designs by 9 December 2019 for expressions of interests for new logos / colours / branding.

6. Qualifications Update

- (a) Rhys confirmed he has been in contact with New Zealand Parkour Association.
- (b) NZ have finished their qualifications, and seek to eventually have inter-jurisdiction recognition.
- (c) At end of January, Rhys to attend the first professional pathway course in New Zealand (Hamilton)

- (a) Committee agreed Parkour NSW should not be seen to support Free G or any Free G activities.

8. General Business
